**EXPERIENCE THE TRANSFORMATION!** In a recent conversation about prayer, a controversial opinion emerged, which had to do with the relevance of prayer in a decadent world.



On the one hand, the feeling is that an avalanche of destructive acts are going unabated, even in the wake of increase intercessory prayer. On the other hand, many believe that prayer provides an opportunity for the formation of character, even though situations do not improve immediately. From this perspective the relevance of prayer has to do with who we become and not so much the immediate change of situations. For example, one who prays in difficult times develop patience (Luke 18:1-8). It has become common today to denounce prayer because answers may be delayed. Though I concede that we don't know everything about the efficacy of prayer, I maintain that prayer is relevant even though answers may not come immediately. God gets out of us what we become in prayer. Let us come together this week for Week of Prayer.
