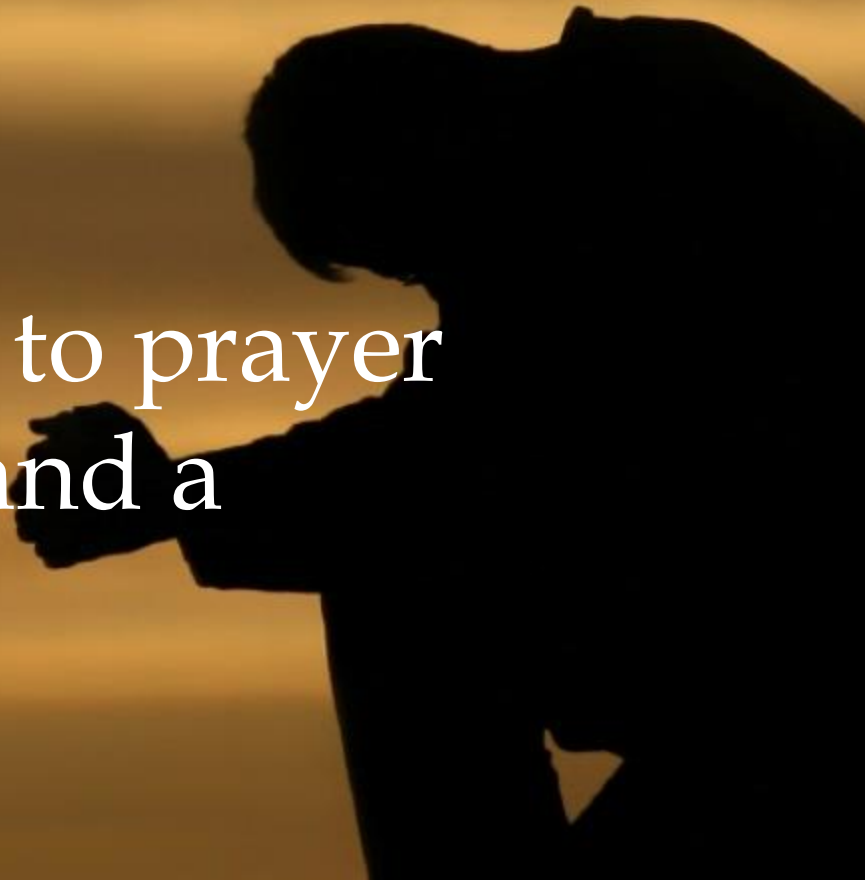

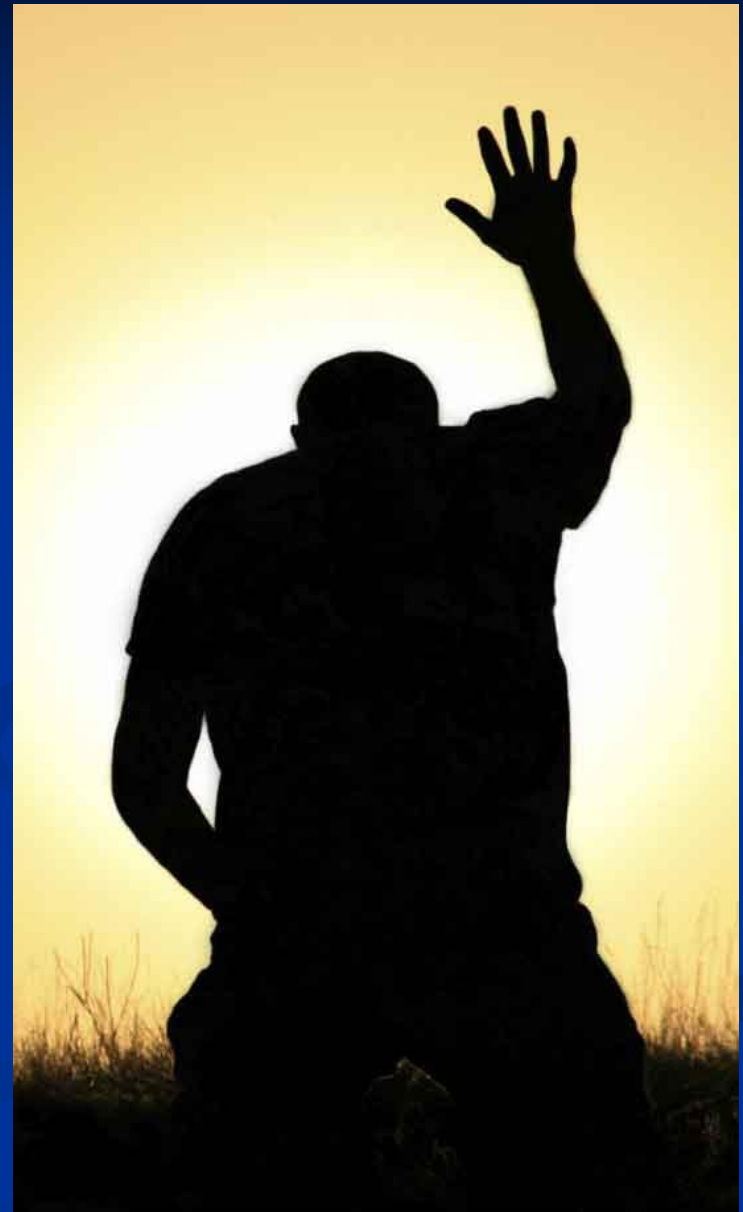
“Devote yourselves to prayer

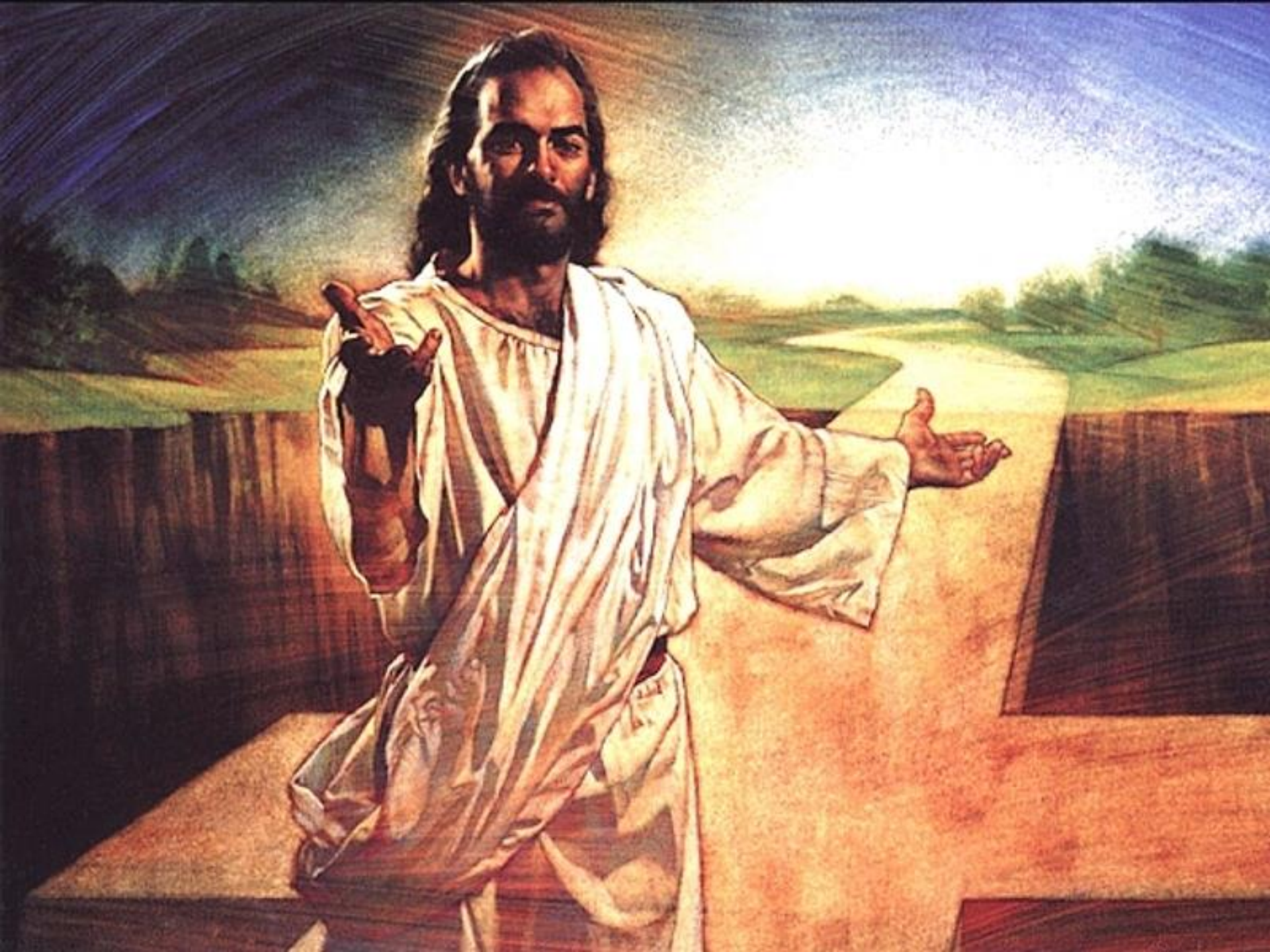
